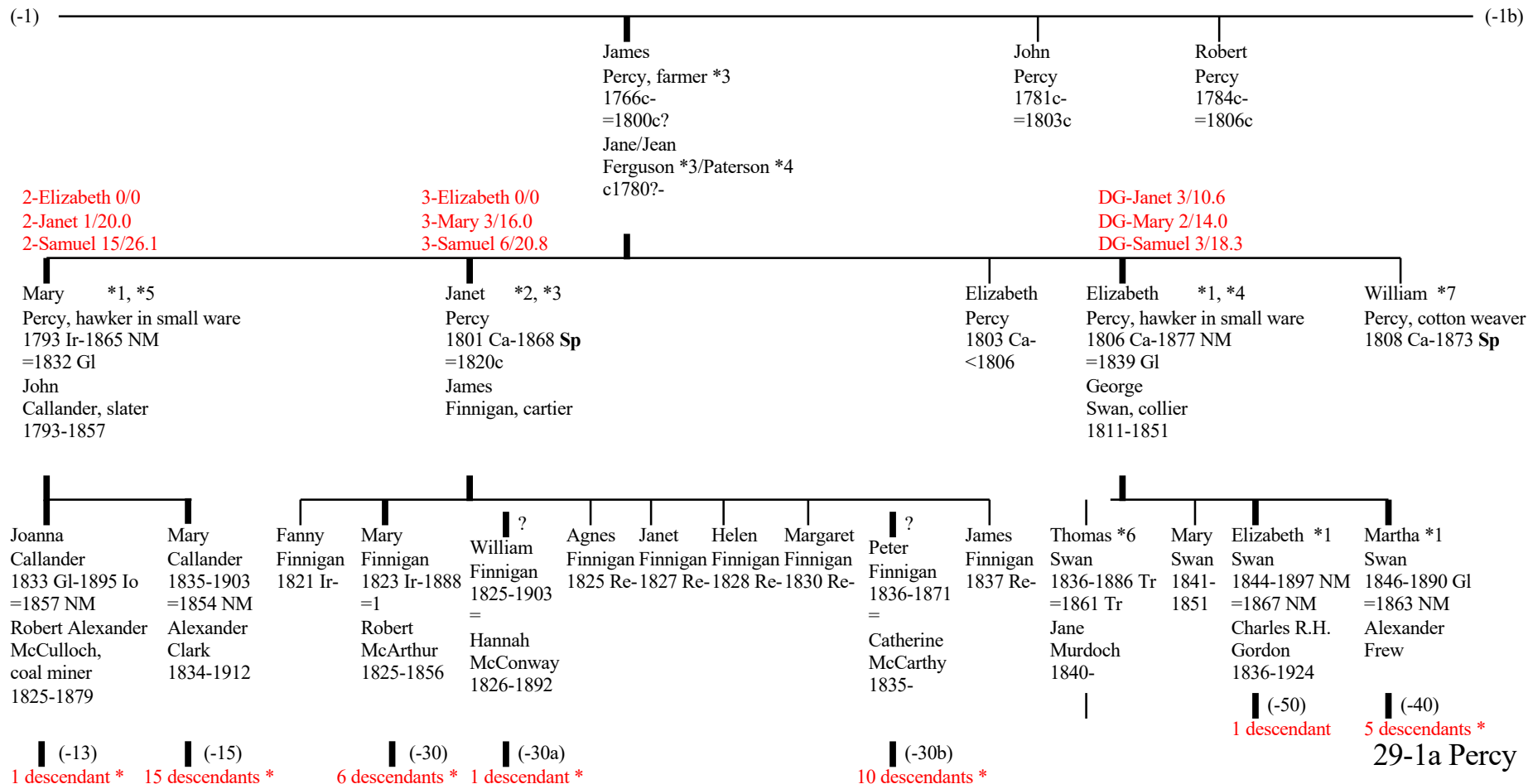


DNA confirmation: # of matches/average cM

(informant Gov. of poorhouse – less reliable?)  
\*4 Death certificate: aged 72, parents  
**James Percy + Jean Paterson**  
\*5 Death certificate: aged 72, parents  
not named  
\*6 mother McNeil on death certificate  
\*7 1871 census in Springburn Poorhouse,  
no parents on death certificate
